

Thanks to Friends of Frances, the Frances Banta Waggoner Library offers a select number of passes to area attractions and museums for library users to check-out free of charge. To make this service possible, we have agreed to follow the policies and restrictions for each institution.

General Information about library museum & local attraction passes:

1. All passes are available on a first come, first serve basis.
2. No reserves or renewals are made for *any* of the passes
3. One pass per household is limited at the time of check-out.
4. Replacement cost for a lost/missing pass is \$50.00.

Museum Passes: (Applies to Putnam Museum, The Clinton Sawmill Museum, and Felix Adler Children's Discovery Center):

1. Open to *everyone* living in Clinton County.
2. The number of persons admitted per pass ranges from 4-6 people, depending on the institution. See library staff for details.
3. Loan period is a maximum of three days, but the library appreciates if patrons return as soon as possible so other library users may access the passes.

DeWitt Aquatic Center Pass:

Per the DeWitt Aquatic Center Policy, the library must adhere to the same policies and procedures outlined by the pool board. The following restrictions are for library check-out eligibility *only*. It is the library user's responsibility to ensure they are following the Aquatic Center rules & policies while visiting the pool facilities.

1. Library users must be at least 18 years old to check out. Any child 6 or younger must be under the direct supervision of someone at least 16 years at all times.
2. The Library Aquatic Center pass covers residents who live in the DeWitt school District—DeWitt (including county), Low Moor, Grand Mound, and Welton. No exceptions.
3. Admission is limited to the dependents claimed on the taxes of the adult who checks out the pool pass to their account. For example, the pool will not grant entrance for a babysitter & their charges to enter the pool free of charge using the library's pool pass.
4. One check out per month during pool season per household, to ensure the maximum number of library users are given the opportunity to enjoy the pool facilities.
5. Loan period is 24 hours.

Policies and restrictions come from the agreement made with each institution. Failure to adhere to these policies would result in the library losing all access to Museum/Attraction passes.
